Our Mission is to improve the safety of the University of South Florida (USF) campus community through an ongoing 4 pronged approach: 1) a recurring emergency medical responder (EMR) state certification course, 2) provision of direct basic life support and first aid, 3) medical mentoring opportunities for students and 4) automated external defibrillator (AED) and cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR) initiatives.

Our Goal is to raise funding for the equipment essential to expand and support these a well-established campus-based, student run, volunteer EMS programs.

History: The University Emergency Medical Student Association (UEMSA) was established in 2004 as a student organization comprised of emergency medical responders (EMRs), emergency medical technicians (EMTs), and Paramedics. UEMSA has 4 Primary Service Functions:

First Primary Service Function - For more than a decade UEMSA has taught an 8 week EMR course every semester where our students learn medical skills and earn a state EMR certification that allows them to volunteer with our organization and help their fellow students. By educating our community in emergency medicine we improve the safety of our campus. Currently, the funds for our operations are generated by the Emergency Medical Responder course. That revenue provides the support for our equipment and all primary service functions.

Second Primary Service Function - providing medical standby for campus events and for USF organizations that request UEMSA medical services. At these events we provide Basic Life Support (BLS) and first aid for students, faculty and staff, and visitors to USF.

Third Primary Service Function - UEMSA works in conjunction with Student Health Services' Health Support Staff Program to provide certified students the opportunity to experience hands-on clinical care and receive medical mentoring while earning volunteer or internship service hours working with the physicians and nurses at the campus clinic.

Fourth Primary Service Function – UEMSA works with USF's Environmental Health and Safety (EH&S) Department to promote and establish programs which focus on mapping, checking, and inspecting the automatic external defibrillators (AEDs) on campus. UEMSA has trained teams of students to go out under the auspices of EH&S to inventory and evaluate the working status of all the AEDs throughout our Tampa campus. UEMSA is integral to the USF policy of insuring that all faculty, staff and students to have access to life-saving medical equipment.

Your Donations will allow us to replenish our medical supplies, operate an emergency transport vehicle, provide students the opportunity unity to experience medicine first-hand, and improve the safety of the USF community. Your contribution would directly go towards funding an ambulance, a stretcher, medical supplies, radio communication equipment, and uniforms so that we can expand the EMS system of care on our campus. As an organization we seek to improve the standard for safety at the University of South Florida and we need your help.
